By the grace of Allah Ta'ala, we are pleased to share a brief report on the Wings of Mercy Foundation's 2025–2026 operations. We thank Allah (SWT) for allowing us to serve His cause, and we sincerely pray that He accepts your donations and our efforts. We are deeply grateful to you, our donors, for your trust and continued support in assisting orphans and those in need.

Since the October 2023 war on Gaza, the humanitarian need has been immense, leading to the launch of the Gaza Relief Project. Over the past year, displacement and orphanhood have increased dramatically, while infrastructure has been severely damaged. Significant financial support remains essential to provide food, clothing, shelter, education, and basic necessities.

Alhamdulillah, 15 months later, we welcome the end of the conflict in Gaza. With your generous contributions, Wings of Mercy was able to support orphans, displaced families, and those affected throughout the war.

Our work does not end here. Together, we will continue to rebuild, heal, and restore hope, Insha'Allah.



ORPHAN SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM GAZA

The Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) said: “The one who cares for an orphan and I will be together in Paradise like this,” and he held his two fingers—the index and middle finger—together to illustrate. This profound narration highlights the immense virtue, reward, and closeness to the Prophet in the afterlife for those who sponsor, support, and care for an orphan.

In the Gaza Strip, orphaned children face hardships that no child should ever have to endure. Many have lost not only one or both parents, but also the sense of safety, stability, and childhood itself. They grow up surrounded by destruction, displacement, and constant uncertainty, often carrying deep emotional trauma alongside the daily struggle for food, warmth, education, and care. Without the protection of parents, these children are among the most vulnerable, facing loneliness, fear, and the heavy burden of surviving in an environment where opportunities are scarce and hope is fragile. In response to this profound need, our orphan sponsorship program has become one of the biggest and longest-running projects at the Wings of Mercy Foundation. This program is a lifeline for orphaned children in Gaza, providing consistent support that helps meet their basic needs while offering reassurance, dignity, and a sense of belonging. Through long-term sponsorship, we strive to restore hope, nurture resilience, and remind every orphaned child that they are not forgotten, that their lives matter, and that mercy continues to reach them even in the most difficult circumstances.

EGYPT TO GAZA CONVOY

In 2025, through the grace of Allah and the donations of our generous donors, the Wings of Mercy Foundation organized another lifeline for Gaza through an aid convoy from Egypt, carrying hope across borders weighed down by suffering. The trucks were loaded in Egypt with food parcels that held only the bare minimum, yet meant everything to families facing scorching hunger—basic staples meant to keep life going for just a little longer. Every box represented care, sacrifice, and an urgent response to empty kitchens and exhausted parents who have nothing left to give their children. When the convoy finally reached Gaza, the parcels were distributed to the brave people enduring unimaginable conditions, people who continue to stand, love, and survive despite loss, fear, and deprivation. In the face of cruelty and neglect, this convoy was a quiet reminder that Gaza is not forgotten, and that mercy can still find its way through even the harshest realities.

FOOD PARCEL DISTRIBUTION

In Gaza, it was not only homes that were demolished, but life itself. Families were left living in tents, surrounded by loss, hunger, and uncertainty. Alhamdulillah, through the mercy of Allah and the generous donations of you all, we were able to reach these families and distribute food parcels around the tent communities in Gaza. Each parcel contained only the most basic survival foods, yet to those receiving them, they meant everything. They meant another day of life, a meal instead of emptiness, and hope instead of despair. In a place where starvation threatened every breath, these parcels helped keep families alive and protected them from the cruelty of hunger.

FISH DISTRIBUTION

In a place where food is no longer available, where desperation has pushed the people of Gaza to eat leaves from trees just to stay alive, hunger has reached an unthinkable depth. Children have been starving to death, and parents carry a sorrow so heavy it breaks them as they watch their families fade before their eyes. In these forgotten shelters, where suffering is often unseen, we carried out a fish distribution to offer families a rare chance at nourishment. The fish gave them something warm to cook for the day, something real to place in front of their children, and a small relief from the constant ache of hunger. That night, many families slept with slightly filled stomachs—still surrounded by pain and loss, but held for a moment by the quiet comfort of having eaten, and the reminder that they had not been completely abandoned. The sad eyes of our beloved children smiled for a second as they whispered a broken thank you.





FLOUR DISTRIBUTION

In the crushing days of 2025, when hunger hollowed homes and hope felt unbearably fragile in Gaza, the flour distribution project reached families with something painfully simple yet profoundly powerful: flour. Just a small packet, light in weight but heavy with meaning. Mothers held it as if it were treasure, knowing it meant one more day their children would not sleep hungry. Children—whose eyes had grown tired far too soon—clutched it with quiet wonder, and for a fleeting moment, their faces softened into shy, content smiles. In a place where loss had become routine, this simple act whispered a reminder of humanity: that they were seen, remembered, and not alone.

WINTER AID

Winter in Gaza is a season of suffering, where bitter cold and relentless rain worsen the already devastating conditions families endure. Children shiver in thin clothing, fragile and weak, some even falling gravely ill from the piercing cold, while elderly parents struggle to keep themselves and their grandchildren warm, sometimes freezing through the nights. The rain pours relentlessly, seeping into tents, soaking belongings, and at times collapsing what little shelter remains, leaving families exposed to the harsh elements with nowhere to hide. In the face of such hardship, our Winter Aid Campaign aimed to bring warmth and protection to those most vulnerable. Through the distribution of blankets and winter clothing, we reached children and families living in these harsh conditions, offering them not just warmth, but a measure of hope and dignity. For those braving the freezing nights, these simple items became lifelines, shielding them from the cold and reminding them that compassion and care can still reach them even in the bleakest moments.

WATER

In Gaza, access to clean drinking water is a daily struggle that affects every member of the community, children, mothers, fathers, the elderly, and even babies, leaving many without a basic necessity that the world often takes for granted. Contaminated water, scarcity, and long waits for limited supplies turn something as simple as drinking or cooking into a constant battle for survival. Through our clean water campaign, we were able to provide every family with a vital lifeline of water, a drop of hope to sustain life and preserve health. For many, this water was more than hydration; it was a symbol of care, relief, and humanity in the midst of unending hardship. Watching the smiles of children running to get their share and drinking safely, mothers able to prepare meals without fear, and families reclaiming a small measure of normalcy, reminded us that even the simplest act of giving water can restore dignity, protect life, and bring light to lives shadowed by struggle.

SANITARY PADS

As part of our humanitarian efforts, we implemented a sanitary pad distribution campaign for the women of Gaza, whose strength and resilience in the face of relentless hardship is nothing short of remarkable. These women endure loss, displacement, and deprivation with quiet courage, often placing the needs of their families far above their own. In conditions where privacy is scarce and basic necessities are unavailable, something as simple as menstrual hygiene becomes a heavy and painful burden. This campaign was a deeply humane act — an effort to return a sense of dignity, modesty, and comfort to women who have been forced to live without them. By providing these essential items, we aimed to ease not only physical hardship but also emotional distress, allowing women to feel seen, respected, and cared for. In restoring this small but vital sense of normalcy, we honored their dignity and acknowledged the silent strength they carry every single day.

BREAD DISTRIBUTION

In Gaza, where hunger has become a daily shadow and even a piece of bread feels like a distant hope, the Wings of Mercy Foundation carried out a humble yet deeply human bread distribution project. Families stood with tired eyes and empty hands, hearts heavy from days of searching for food that simply does not exist, their children waiting for something—anything—to quiet their hunger. With scarce resources and aching determination, the foundation's team began from nothing: mixing flour by hand, measuring water carefully, kneading dough on worn surfaces, and lighting simple ovens, knowing that each loaf carried more than nourishment—it carried dignity and survival. As the bread slowly baked, the air filled with a warmth that briefly softened the harshness of reality, and when the loaves were finally placed into waiting hands, there were tears, whispered prayers, and silent gratitude. In a place where life feels stripped down to its most painful essentials, this bread was not just food, but a small, defiant act of mercy against despair. The bread came as a beacon of hope to the fragile tents in the most vulnerable places in Gaza.





SHOPPING VOUCHER

As part of our humanitarian initiatives, we launched a shopping voucher campaign in Gaza to assist families in obtaining essential groceries, which have become increasingly difficult to afford due to scarcity and soaring prices. These vouchers gave families the dignity and freedom to choose the food they needed most, easing the constant pressure of providing for their households. In a place where even basic staples can feel out of reach, this initiative brought not only nourishment but also relief, hope, and a small measure of normalcy to families struggling to survive.

BABY MILK AND DIAPER

In May 2025 and again in September 2025, through the grace of the Almighty and by the help of our donors, the Wing of Mercy Foundation answered Gaza's most fragile cries with an urgent relief project for baby milk and diapers, reaching families who had nothing left to give their children but faith. In a place where parents measured days by survival, these simple essentials became lifelines—restoring dignity, easing hunger, and letting helpless mothers hold their babies for just one more night.

BABY FORMULA DISTRIBUTION

In a place where little babies were cruelly deprived of milk, where cries of hunger echoed through shattered homes and innocence suffered an unbearable injustice, the pain was beyond words. It was harsh, inhumane, and absolutely heartbreaking to witness mothers helplessly trying to comfort infants whose only need was nourishment. These were sacred young souls, far too small to understand war, yet forced to endure its brutality. In the midst of this darkness, we were able to bring a fragile but powerful light. By distributing baby formula to parents in Gaza, we restored more than sustenance, we offered relief, dignity, and a moment of peace. For those babies, each bottle meant warmth instead of hunger, life instead of loss, and a reminder that even in the deepest suffering, compassion still survives.

EID GIFTS AND CLOTHING

The distribution of Qurbani meat was more than a source of nourishment; it was a reminder of unity, mercy, and the enduring meaning of Eid, a reminder that they are not alone, not forgotten, and not abandoned.

FOOD PARCEL DISTRIBUTION

Movement restrictions, economic instability, and limited access to work mean that many parents struggle simply to earn enough to put food on the table. The journey to bring food home can be exhausting and uncertain, marked by checkpoints, long delays, and rising prices that place unbearable pressure on already fragile households. We were able to carry out a food parcel distribution project through which we sought to stand beside families facing these realities, providing essential nourishment and a sense of dignity, hope, and relief in lives shaped by constant struggle and resilience.
